We take the health of our students and our campus community seriously at Wabash. Our nationkeld-Student Health Center is staffed Monday Friday, with a RN and a certified nurse practitioner. Visits with a family physician are available by appointment. Incoming students must complete their personal and family health history as well as other required forms, including mandatory immunization records, utilizing the online student health portal of our electronic medical records system (signin information provided to students separately).

# Documentation of the following:

- x Polio series (IPV or OPVf)our doseş last dose on/after age four
- x MMR (measles, mumps, rubella) wo doses
  - o Doseone must be given on or after the first birthday; the second dose at least 28 days later
  - o Laboratory iters may be submitted as evidence of immunity
- x Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussish-addition to completion of the primary series, one dose within at least 10 years of enrollment date
- x Varicella (chicken pox)two doses of vaccin@R medical documentation of disease, from natural disease
- x Meningococcal ACWY (also called MAC) ∀at least onedose is sufficient if given after age 6
  - There is a new vaccine, Penbraya, which includes ABCWY, five types of meningitis strains, for enhanced protection

### RECOMMENDED VACCINATIONS

- x Meningococcal B two doses (this type of meningitis is the most prevalent in Indiana, and has been associated with past college outbreaks, so we strongly recommend it); please note, there are two brands, and they are not interchangeable. Both doses should be of the same brand (Trumemba or Bexsero) to be valid
- x Influenza (we make fighots available on campus for all students and employees each fall)
- x HPV (human papillomavirus) two or three doses, depending on age at first administration
- x SAR&CoV2 (COVID) an updated COVID9 vaccine approved by the Food and Drug Administration (DDWorld Health Organization (WHO)
- x Hepatitis A +two doses
- x Hepatitis B-three doses

## INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- x Required to have an IGRA Tuberculosis (TB) blood test, which we will administer to you once you arrive on campus.
- x If the required immunizations are not available to you in your home country, we will administer those to you during orientation. It is generally more coeffective to obtain vaccines in your home country when possible.
